



# Heidi Parker



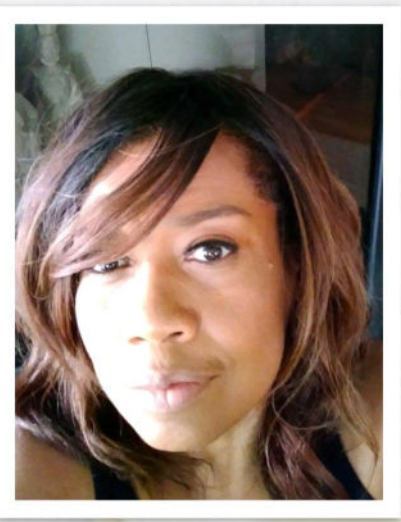

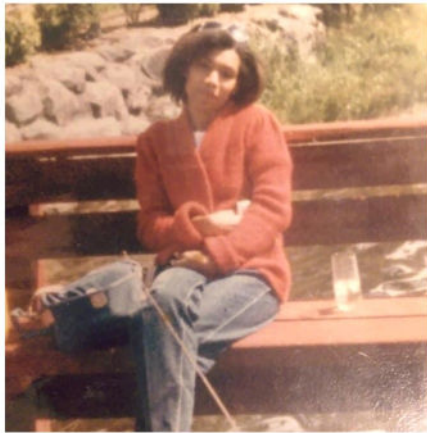


# Heidi Marie Parker



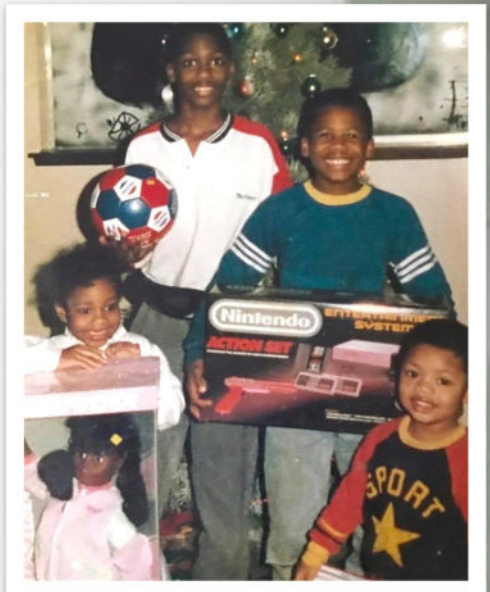
